Deane, Esq. be, and he is hereby authorized to call the first meeting of said Trustees, by giving First meeting, personal notice thereof to each of them; at which meeting they may determine the manner of calling future meetings.

SECT. 7. Be it further enacted, That the powers Powers granted by this Act may be enlarged, restrained or repealed, at the pleasure of the Legislature.

CHAPTER CCXXXI.

AN ACT to incorporate Ligonia Lodge.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Leonard Jarvis, George Brimmer, John Hopkins, Persons incor-Thomas J. Whiting, Porter Sawyer, James C. porated. Fisk, Calvin Peck, and their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of Ligonia Lodge; with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal and to change the same; to make any by-laws, for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and hold, for charitable purposes, any real estate, to the value of three thousand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars; and to give and May hold esgrant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all tate, &c. the privileges usually granted to other societies, instituted for purposes of charity and beneficence.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That the first meeting. meeting of said Corporation shall be holden at such time and place, and notified in such manner as the majority of the persons herein named may direct.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted, That the powers granted by this act, may be enlarged, restrained Powers or repealed, at the pleasure of the Legislature.
