SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the act passed January the twenty-seventh, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three, entitled "An act to set off part of lot numbered nine in the tenth range, in the town of Canton, and annex the same to the town of Jay," be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER CCXLIII.

AN ACT to incorporate the Portland Stage Company.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled*, That Josiah Paine, Alexander Rice, Nathaniel Mendum, their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are constituted a body corporate, by the name of the Portland Stage Company, for the purpose of establishing and continuing a line of Stages from Portland to Portsmouth; with power to prosecute and defend suits at law; to have a common seal and to alter the same; to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of the State; and to take and hold any real and personal estate to the value of forty thousand dollars; and to give and grant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all the privileges usually granted to other corporations for similar purposes: *Provided however*, That the powers granted by this act, may be enlarged, restrained or annulled, at the pleasure of the Legislature.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That Nathaniel Mendum may call the first meeting of said corporation at such time and place, as he may direct, giving reasonable notice to his associates of such time and place.
