CHAPTER CCXLIV.

AN ACT to incorporate the Master, Wardens and members of Washington Lodge.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That* Libbeus Baily, jun. Oliver N. Allen, Joseph Whitney, Jeremiah Fowler, John Boynton, Moses Fuller and Jabez Mowry, and their associates and successors, be, and they are hereby incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the Master, Wardens and members of Washington Lodge; with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal and to change the same; to make any by-laws, for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and hold, for charitable and benevolent purposes, any real estate, to the value of three thousand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of four thousand dollars; and to give and grant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all the powers and privileges usually granted to other societies, instituted for purposes of charity.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted, That the first meeting of said corporation shall be holden at such time and place, and be notified in such manner as Libbeus Bailey, jun. herein named may direct.*

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted, That the powers granted by this act, may be enlarged, restrained or annulled, at the pleasure of the Legislature.*

CHAPTER CCXLV.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Burnham.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the territory included within the following boundaries in the county of Kennebec, to wit: beginning at the west side of twenty-five mile pond, in the north line of Unity; thence west north west on said line to the north west corner of Unity; thence*
