CHAPTER CCLII.

AN Additional ACT respecting the Hallowell and Augusta Bank.

Corporation
continued un-
til 1826, for
certain purpo-
ses.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the President, Directors and Company of the Hallowell and Augusta Bank, incorporated June twenty-third, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, shall be and continue a body corporate until the first day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six, subject to the obligations, and with the rights and privileges belonging to the same, as prescribed in "An act revoking the charter of the Hallowell and Augusta Bank, and providing for the collection and payment of the debts of the corporation and closing its concerns," passed March second, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-one, any thing in said act to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER CCLIII.

AN Additional ACT respecting the Wiscasset Bank.

Corporation
continued un-
til 1826, for
certain purpo-
ses.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the President, Directors and Company of the Wiscasset Bank, shall be and continue a body corporate until the first day of March, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six, subject to the obligations, and with the rights and privileges belonging to the same, as prescribed in "An act restricting the Wiscasset Bank in negotiating business as a banking corporation, and providing for the collection of their debts and for other purposes," passed March the eighth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty one, any thing in said act or in an additional act respecting the Wiscasset Bank, passed the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-two, to the contrary notwithstanding.
