#### CHAPTER CCLXXXIV.

AN ACT establishing an additional term of the Supreme Judicial Court, and Court of Common Pleas, for the County of Oxford, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That, s. J. C. at Pafrom and after the first day of February next, the Tues, on the first Supreme Judicial Court, for said county of Oxford, and 4th Tues, shall be holden at Paris, in said county, on the first Tuesday of January, by any one or more of the Justices thereof; and on the fourth Tuesday of August, by all or any two of the Justices thereof, in each year.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That, from and after the first day of February next, the Court of C.C.P. at PacCommon Pleas shall be holden for said county, at Tues. of Jan. Paris, aforesaid, on the fourth Tuesday of January, 2d Tues. of the second Tuesday of June, and the fourth Tues-Tues. of Sept.

day of September, in each year.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted, That all acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
