CHAPTER CCLXXXIV.

AN ACT establishing an additional term of the Supreme Judicial Court, and Court of Common Pleas, for the County of Oxford, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That, from and after the first day of February next, the Supreme Judicial Court, for said county of Oxford, shall be holden at Paris, in said county, on the first Tuesday of January, by any one or more of the Justices thereof; and on the fourth Tuesday of August, by all or any two of the Justices thereof, in each year.

S. J. C. at Paris, on the first Tues. of Jan. and 4th Tues. of August.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That, from and after the first day of February next, the Court of Common Pleas shall be holden for said county, at Paris, aforesaid, on the fourth Tuesday of January, the second Tuesday of June, and the fourth Tuesday of September, in each year.

C. C. P. at Paris, on the 4th Tues. of Jan. 2d Tues. of June, and 4th Tues. of Sept.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That all acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
