CHAPTER CCLXXXV.

AN ACT in further addition to an Act concerning foreign attach-

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That so much of the first section of an act, entitled "An additional act concerning foreign attachment," Part of former passed February the twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four, as requires the act repealed. Plaintiff and supposed Trustee both to reside in the same county where the Justice has jurisdiction, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER CCLXXXVI.

AN ACT relating to the Duties on Commissions.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House

of Representatives, in Legislature assembled. That, from and after the passing of this act, whenever any person shall be appointed to any civil office, upon Commission not to be made which a duty is now, or hereafter may be required out until the to be paid for the use of the State, no commission duty is paid. shall be made out until said duty has been paid. And

Secretary of it shall be the duty of the Secretary of State forth-State to give notice of ap- with to notify such person of his appointment; and pointment, &c. upon such person's producing from the proper officer a receipt for the amount of the duty required, a commission shall forthwith be made out and delivered to him, or any other person applying therefor by

his authority. Sect. 2. Be it further enacted, That the Secre-

tary of State shall, on the first day of January annually, certify to the Treasurer of the State the amount paid to the several Treasurers of counties, towns and plantations, for duties on commissions

by him delivered, the year preceding.

Sect. 3. Be it further enacted, That all acts, or parts of acts, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
