CHAPTER CCCI.

SALES AND

AN ACT additional to " An Act to incorporate the Kennebec Steam Navigation Company."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the prop-Number of erty of the Kennebec Steam Navigation Company, shares increase which, by the third section of the Act to which this is additional, is divided into two hundred shares, be, and the same is hereby divided into two hundred and eighty seven shares : subject in every other particular to the provisions of the act aforesaid. CHAPTER CCCII.

AN ACT in addition to the Acts incorporating China Academy.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Legislature of this State shall have the right to Powers here-grant any farther powers, to alter, limit or restrain tofore granted any of the powers vested in the trustees of China Academy, by the Acts to which this is in addition, ed. as shall be judged necessary to promote the best interests thereof, the said Trustees having assented thereto.
