CHAPTER CCCI.

AN ACT additional to "An Act to incorporate the Kennebec Steam Navigation Company."

Number of
shares increas-
ed.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the property of the Kennebec Steam Navigation Company, which, by the third section of the Act to which this is additional, is divided into two hundred shares, be, and the same is hereby divided into two hundred and eighty seven shares : subject in every other particular to the provisions of the act aforesaid.

CHAPTER CCCII.

AN ACT in addition to the Acts incorporating China Academy.

Powers here-
tofore granted
may be alter-
ed.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled*, That the Legislature of this State shall have the right to grant any farther powers, to alter, limit or restrain any of the powers vested in the trustees of China Academy, by the Acts to which this is in addition, as shall be judged necessary to promote the best interests thereof, the said Trustees having assented thereto.
