May hold es the laws of this State; to take and hold any real tate, &c. estate, to the value of seven hundred dollars, and personal estate, to the value of twenty three hundred dollars; and to give and grant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all the privileges usually granted to other corporations for similar purposes : *Provided*, That the powers granted by this act may be enlarged, restrained or annulled, at the pleasure may be altered of the Legislature.

CHAPTER CCCXXXV.
