SECT. 5. *Be it further enacted*, That the persons herein before named may call the first meeting of said corporation, at such time and place as they may direct, giving due notice of the same to all persons interested therein. First meeting by whom and how called.

SECT. 6. *Be it further enacted*, That the powers granted by this act may be enlarged, restrained or repealed at the pleasure of the Legislature. Powers may be altered.

## CHAPTER CCCXLIV.

AN ACT to incorporate Adoniram Lodge.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled*, That Arthur McArthur, Nathaniel Clark, jun. and Clement J. Adams, and their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of Adoniram Lodge; with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal, and to change the same; to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and hold for charitable and benevolent uses, any real estate to the value of three thousand dollars; and any personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars; and to give and grant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all the privileges usually granted to other societies, instituted for purposes of charity and beneficence. Persons incorporated.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the first meeting of said corporation, shall be holden at such time and place, and be notified in such manner, as the majority of the persons herein named may direct. Powers and privileges.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That the powers granted by this act may be enlarged, restrained or repealed, at the pleasure of the Legislature. May hold estate, &c.
