The committee on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives, Report, The amount of travel and attendance of the members at the present session, the additional pay of the speaker, and the pay of John Storer, who was returned a member of this House from the District of Mexico, Dixfield and Peru, and whose seat was vacated, and the additional allowance to Daniel Quinnam, for extra service on the committee of accounts, made upon this Roll, by order of the House; together with the pay of the clerk, assistant clerk, door-keeper, page and attendant, to be eighteen thousand and fifty five dollars: and report herewith a Resolve.

#### CHAPTER LXXVIII.

Resolve on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this State, to the several persons mentioned in the preceding Roll, the several sums set against their respective names, amounting to eighteen thousand and fifty-five dollars.
