CHAPTER CCCXX.

AN ACT to authorize the Selectmen of Gardiner to appoint an additional number of Engine-men.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That the Selectmen of the town of Gardiner, in the county of Kennebec, for the time being, be, and they hereby are authorized, in manner by law provided, for the appointment of engine-men, to appoint for the Engine in said town, called the Hydraulion, a number of engine-men, not to exceed thirty-two.

Selectmen of Gardiner authorized to appoint a certain number of Engine men;

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the engine-men so appointed, shall be subject to all the duties and liabilities, and shall be entitled to all the privileges and exemptions of engine-men appointed in manner by law provided.

who are to be subject to the same duties as other Engine men.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That this Act shall be taken and deemed to be a public Act.
