CHAPTER CCCXXXI.

AN ACT in addition to "An Act respecting Engine Men, Fire Engines, and the extinguishment of Fire."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That whenever, hereafter, the inhabitants of any town within this State, shall purchase, obtain, or possess, for their use, any Fire Engine, that may Additional Enrequire a greater number of men to work the ginemen may be appointed by Sesame, than are attached to the Engines now in lectimen of lowns in certain cases. common use, that the Selectmen of any such town be, and are hereby authorized, if they judge it expedient to nominate and appoint a number of suitable persons, not exceeding thirtytwo, to be engine men, who shall be liable to all the duties and penalties, and entitled to all the privileges and exemptions, of the Act aforesaid, to which this is in addition.

CHAPTER CCCXXXII.

AN ACT additional to "An Act establishing the duties to be paid by certain officers therein named."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Duty on commissions of Coro so much of the Act, to which this is in addition, ners repealed. as requires each Coroner to pay a duty of three dollars, be, and hereby is repealed.

CHAPTER CCCXXXIII.

AN ACT to prevent intemperance at Elections.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That no person shall be allowed to sell or No strong liquots expose to sale within the limits of two hundred days within 200 rods from any place where the inhabitants of any rods of place of meeting.
