they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of The Morning Star Lodge; with power to prosecute and defend suits at law; Powers, &c. to have a common seal, which they may change at pleasure; to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of the State; to take and hold, for chari-May hold estate, table and benevolent uses, any real estate, to the value of three thousand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars, and to give and grant, or bargain and sell the same; and with all the powers and privileges usually granted to other societies, instituted for similar purposes.

Sect. 2. Be it further enacted, That the first meeting of said corporation shall be held at such time and place, and be notified in such manner, First meeting as a majority of the persons named herein may

direct.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted, That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, Powers restricted restricted, or annulled at the pleasure of the Legislature.

CHAPTER CCCLXIII.

AN ACT to change the name of the town of Joy.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That from and after the passage of this Act, the town of Joy, in the County of Kennebec, shall be known and called by the name of Montgomery; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
