CHAPTER CCCLXXVIII.

AN ACT to incorporate the Solar Lodge.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That Zina Hyde, John Elwell and Matthew B. Plumstead, their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of Solar Lodge; and by that name may prosecute and defend suits at law; with power to have and use a common seal; to make and establish any by-laws, for the convenient management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and hold for charitable and benevolent purposes any real estate to the value of three thousand dollars, and any personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars; and to give, grant, bargain or sell the same; and with all other powers and privileges usually granted to other societies instituted for purposes of charity and beneficence.

Persons incorporated.

Powers, &c.

May hold estate, &c.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the first meeting of said corporation shall be held at such time and place, and be notified in such manner, as a majority of the persons named in this Act shall direct.

First meeting.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, restricted or annulled, at the pleasure of the Legislature.
