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### CHAPTER CCCLXXVIII.

AN ACT to incorporate the Solar Lodge.

**BE** it enacted by the Senate and SECT. 1. House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Zina Hyde, John Elwell and Matthew Persons Incorpo B. Plumstead, their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of Solar Lodge; and by that name may prosecute and defend suits Powers, &c. at law; with power to have and use a common seal; to make and establish any by-laws, for the convenient management of their affairs, not May hold estate repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and the hold for charitable and benevolent purposes any real estate to the value of three thousand dollars. and any personal estate to the value of five thousand dollars; and to give, grant, bargain or sell the same; and with all other powers and privileges usually granted to other societies instituted for purposes of charity and beneficence.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That the first meeting of said corporation shall be held at such time and place, and be notified in such manner, First meeting. as a majority of the persons named in this Act shall direct.

SECT. 3. Be it further enacted, That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, Powers restricted restricted or annulled, at the pleasure of the Legislature.
