Be it further enacted, That the Sест. 4. inhabitants hereby incorporated, shall be holden to pay all taxes, which have been assessed upon Inhabitants hold them, as inhabitants, either of Etna or of plantation number five, previous to the passing of this Act: And the collectors of taxes, in the said town of Etna, and plantation number five, shall have the same power to enforce the collection of such taxes, as if this Act had not passed.

## CHAPTER CCCCVI.

#### AN ACT to change the names of certain Banks.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the several Banks herein named, incorporated by the Legislature of this State, shall hereafter be allowed to take the names following, that is to say, the Casco Bank, the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Casco Bank; the Names changed. Union Bank, the name af the President, Directors and Company of the Union Bank; the Merchants Bank, the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Merchants Bank; the Manufacturers Bank, the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Manufacturers Bank; and the Vassalborough Bank, the name of the President, Directors and Company of the Vassalborough Bank; any thing in their several Acts of incorporation, to the contrary notwithstanding.
