CHAPTER LVII.

Resolve for the payment of contingent expenses.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of seven hundred dollars, for the payment of contingent expenses of the current political year, to be placed at the disposal of the Governor, and for the expenditure of which, he is to be accountable.

[*Approved by the Governor, March 6, 1826.*]

CHAPTER LVIII.

Resolve for the purchase of Stationary.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of three hundred dollars, for the purchase of Stationary, for the several offices and the Legislature ; to be placed in the hands of the Secretary of State ; and for the expenditure of which, he is to be accountable.
