CHAPTER CCCCLXXIII.

AN ACT to extend the time for building Rumford Bridge.

Time, within which to erect the Bridge, extended.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the further time of four years from the passing of this Act, be, and hereby is granted to the Proprietors of Rumford Bridge to build and complete said Bridge.

CHAPTER CCCCLXXIV.

AN ACT repealing the Act to set off Cornelius Thompson and his estate from the town of Bowdoin to the town of Lisbon.

Former act repealed.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That an Act, passed January the thirty-first, in the year eighteen hundred and twenty-six, to set off Cornelius Thompson and his estate, from the town of Bowdoin to the town of Lisbon, be, and the same hereby is repealed.
