CHAPTER CCCCLXXXI.

AN ACT to change the name of New Charlestown.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the town of New Charlestown, in the county of Penobscot, shall be called and known hereafter, by the name of Charlestown.

CHAPTER CCCCLXXXII.

AN ACT ceding to the United States the jurisdiction of certain lands near the mouth of Piscatagua River.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Jurisdiction of certain lands at the mouth of list there be, and hereby is ceded to the United cataqua river ce-ded. States, the jurisdiction of the ledge of rocks, called Whale's Back; and also the ledge of rocks called Wood Island, containing about

acres, both being situated near the mouth of Piscataqua river, for the purpose of erecting a Light House and any other buildings thereon, which may be found expedient by the Government Concurrent jurisdiction reserved of the United States: Provided however, That this State shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the United States in and over said territory, hereby ceded, for the purpose of executing and serving all civil and criminal process under the authority thereof.
