SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the first meeting of said corporation, shall be called ^{First meeting, how called, &c.} at such time and place, as shall be determined upon, by a majority of the persons named in the first section of this Act.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, ^{Powers restricted.} restricted or annulled, at the pleasure of the Legislature.
