CHAPTER CCCLXXI.

AN ACT to alter the time for holding the Fall Term of the Court of Sessions in the County of Oxford.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That, from and after the passing of this Act, the fall term of the Court of Sessions, within and for the county of Oxford, shall be held on the last Tuesday of October annually, and not on the second Tuesday of said month as heretofore established by law.

Last Tuesday of Oct. instead of the first.

[Approved by the Governor, January 18, 1828.]



CHAPTER CCCLXXII.

AN ACT additional to an Act, entitled "An Act establishing the County of Waldo."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That, from and after the passage of this Act, the dividing line between the Counties of Hancock and Waldo, shall be the middle of the channel of the Penobscot river and bay, commencing*

in the middle of said river, at the northerly line of said county of Waldo, and descending the same, leaving Orphan Island on the east, and Islesborough on the west, till it intersects a line drawn due east from the southern corner of said county of Waldo.

Additional Term

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That, from and after the passage of this act, in addition to the terms of the Court of Sessions by law established, in and for the county of Waldo, a term of said Court shall be held annually at Belfast, in and for said county, on the third Tuesday of August; at which term the Justices of said Court shall have and exercise the same powers and jurisdiction which they now have or may have and exercise at any other term of said Court.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted*, That, from and after ten days from the passage of this Act, the thirteenth section of an Act, to which this is additional, passed February seventh, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, shall be repealed; and that "an Act in addition to an Act concerning Registers of Deeds," passed February fifth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, shall, from and after said ten days, be in full force and effect in said county of Waldo.

SECT. 4. *Be it further enacted*, That any thing contained in the Act to which this is additional, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER CCCLXXIII.

AN ACT establishing the Salaries of the Judge and Register of Probate for the County of Waldo.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the salary of the Judge of Probate in the county of
