CHAPTER CCCCIX.

AN ACT to repeal the laws which provide for the appointment of Road Commissioners.

Acts providing for the appointment of Road Commissioners repealed.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That so much of an Act entitled "An Act to repeal an Act to establish Courts of Sessions and for establishing Courts of Sessions," passed the twenty fifth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five, and so much of "an additional Act respecting highways," passed the twenty fourth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, as provide for the appointment of Standing Committees to view and lay out roads, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Court of Sessions vested with the power of appointing Committees for that purpose.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That whenever the Court of Sessions within and for either of the counties of this State, shall adjudge it necessary and expedient to view or locate any road or roads within their respective counties, said Courts of Sessions are hereby vested with the power of appointing committees for such purposes, and to fix their compensation.

[Approved by the Governor, February 26, 1828.]

CHAPTER CCCCX.

AN additional ACT for the relief of Poor Debtors.

Limits of gaol yards established.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That from and after the first day of June next, the limits of each respective county in this State shall be, remain and become the boundaries of the gaol yard to each and every gaol within such county: *Provided,* That until a gaol be erected and ready to be occupied in the county of
