PUBLIC LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE.

CHAPTER CCCCXII.

AN ACT to authorize the Court of Sessions in the County of Lincoln, to lay out a Road across Friendship River.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Court of Sessions for the County of Lincoln be, and they hereby are authorized to cause a Road to be located and laid out from the north end of a road in the town of Friendship, across said River, immediately above a Tide Mill, called Friendship Mill, to the south end of a road in the town of Cushing, leading to said Mills.

Court of Sessions authorized to lay out a road across Friendship river, above Friendship-mill.

CCCCXIII.

AN ACT in further addition to the several Acts, now in force, to organize, govern and discipline the Militia of this State.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That companies raised at large, by voluntary enlistment, may establish by-laws and regu-
