#### CHAP. 5.

AN ACT additional to "An Act to incorporate the proprietors of Old Vol. 1, chap, 467. Town Bridge."

Approved January 29, 1829.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That so much of the second section of the Parts of act of 1827 Act, to which this is additional, as relates to the Vol. 1, chap. 487, width of said bridge, and so much of the same repealed. section as relates to the time for building the same, and also so much of the third section of said Act, as relates to the time when the Legislature may further regulate the tolls of said bridge, be, and the same hereby are repealed.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That the Bridge to be built bridge aforesaid shall be, at least, twenty six feet within two years & wide; and if said corporation shall neglect to build and complete said bridge, within two years from the passage of this Act, then the Act, to

which this is additional, shall be void.

Legislature shall have the right to revise and ration of 40 years, change the rates of toll established in said Act, at change the rates of toll established in said Act, at any time after the expiration of forty years, from the time when said bridge is first opened for pas-Comporation at all sengers: Provided, That the said corporation

vert to the State.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Lincoln.

Sect. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the river townships numbered two and
