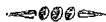

CHAP. 11.

An additional ACT respecting the Winthrop Bank.

Approved February 5, 1829.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the President, Directors and Company of the Winthrop Bank shall be, and continue a body corporate, for and during the term of one year from the passing of this Act; subject to the obligations, and with the rights and privileges belonging to the same, as prescribed in "An Act revoking the charter of the Winthrop Bank," passed the thirtieth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight, any thing in said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
