CHAP. 17.

Act of 1827, vol. 1, An additional ACT to incorporate the Proprietors of the Falls Sluiceway. chap. 480.

Approved February 12, 1829.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That a further time of two years from and after the passing of this Act, shall be allowed to the Proprietors of the Falls Sluiceway, to erect and complete the Sluiceway, which they were empowered to erect and complete by an act of the Legislature of this State, passed the twenty third day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, without forfeiting their charter, or losing any powers, privileges or immunities granted them by said Act.
