CHAP 30.

AN ACT incorporating the Eastern Stage Company.

Approved February 18, 1829.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Thomas Pickard, Asa Eastman, Persons incorpora-Spencer Arnold, Thomas Eastman, their associates and successors, be and hereby are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name of the Eastern Stage Company, for the purpose of establishing and running a line of stages between the Kennebec and Penobscot Rivers; with power, by that name to prosecute and defend suits at law: to have a common seal, and to change the same at pleasure; to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of the State; to take and hold any real and personal May hold real and estate to the value of ten thousand dollars, and to the value of \$10,- give, grant, bargain or sell the same; with all the privileges usually granted to similar corporate bodies. **Provided however**, That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, restrained or annulled at the pleasure of the Legislature.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That Thomas Pickard, may call the first meeting of said corpo-First meeting how ration, at such time and place as he may think called proper, giving seasonable notice thereof to his associates.

CHAP. 31.
