RESOLVED, That each Register of Deeds within each county and district in this State, shall, from and after the first day of April next, and until the first day of January next, keep a true and exact account of all fees received by him or which have accrued and may be due him by virtue of his said office. And it shall be the duty of each Register aforesaid, within ten days next after the said first day of January, to return under oath to the Secretary of State, a true copy of said account.
