## CHAP. 51.

Resolve for the payment of accounts against the State.

Approved March 6, 1829

**RESOLVED**, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State, out of any monies not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons mentioned in ROLL NUMBER TEN, the sums set against such persons names respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of ten thousand four hundred seventy eight dollars and ninety cents, in full discharge of the accounts and demands to which they refer.

## CHAP. 52.

Resolve for the payment of Contingent Expenses.

Approved March 6, 1829

**RESOLVED**, That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of seven hundred dollars, for the payment of Contingent Expenses of the current political year, to be placed at the disposal of the Governor, and for the expenditure of which he is to be accountable.
