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CHAPTER CCCCLXV.

AN ACT to repeal part of " an Act making further provision concern-ing records of Justices of the Peace."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled. 'That 2nd Sec of chapter the 2d section of "an Act making further provision concerning records of Justices of the Peace," passed the fifth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine, be, and hereby is repealed.

CHAPTER CCCCLXVI.

AN ACT additional to an Act to secure to owners their property in Logs, Masts, Spars and other timber in certain cases.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That from Penalty for taking and after the passing of this Act, if any person or logs, &c. wherever found without conpersons shall take, carry away, or otherwise sent of owners aud how recovered, convert to his or their own use, without the consent of the owner, any log suitable to be sawed or
