CHAPTER CCCCLXXXIV.

An additional ACT establishing Circuit Courts Martial.

Chapter 367.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That any two of the members of any Circuit Court Martial, shall constitute a quorum for the trial of all causes within their jurisdiction; in which case the senior officer, being a member of the Court, (if it shall happen that the President of the Court be absent or on trial) shall exercise the office of President. And so much of the act to which this is additional, as is inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be, and hereby is repealed.

Any two members may try causes, &c.

In absence of President, senior member to preside.
