CHAP. 85.

AN ACT in addition to the several Acts “ for the preservation of Fish in Penobscot River and Bay, and the several streams that empty into the same.

Approved March 8, 1830.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That so much of the third section of “ An Act for the preservation of Fish in Penobscot River and Bay, and the several streams emptying into the same,” passed the twenty second day of February, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fourteen, as requires passage ways in the weirs erected in the waters of Penobscot Bay and River to be kept open and clear from sunrise on Friday in each week to sunrise on Monday in the succeeding week, be, and hereby is repealed, and in lieu thereof, such passage ways shall be kept open and clear from sunrise on Saturday in each week to sunrise on Monday in the succeeding week.

Part of Act of 22d Feb. 1814 repealed and another provision substituted therefor.



CHAP. 86.

Former Acts Vol. 1, chaps. 74, 100, 353, 510. Vol. 2, chap. 46. AN ACT in addition to an Act to establish the Cumberland and Oxford Canal Corporation.

Approved March 9, 1830.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the property and concerns of the Cumberland and Oxford Canal Corporation, shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Commissioners, to consist of three or five Stockholders, as the corporation from year to year shall deem necessary: who shall be annually elected at a Stockholders meeting, to be held on such day in January or February, and notified in such manner as in

Board of Commissioners to be chosen
