CHAP. 98.

AN ACT to incorporate the Vassalborough Hemp Manufacturing Company.

Approved March 15, 1830.

Persons incorporat-
ed:

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That Moses Taber, Jacob Southwick, Joseph R. Abbot, George Cox, Scotts Hedge, Robert Winslow and William Howland, their associates and successors, be, and they hereby are incorporated and made a body politic by the name of the Vassalborough Hemp Manufacturing Company, for the purpose of carrying on the manufacture of Hemp in the town of Vassalborough, or Winslow in the county of Kennebec; and for this purpose, shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and requirements, contained in an Act, passed the eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty one, defining the general powers and duties of manufacturing corporations, and in an additional Act, passed the fifth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, exempting from taxation manufacturing companies of cotton, wool, iron and steel for limited times; and shall be exempted from taxation according to the provisions of said Act.

May purchase and hold real and personal estate to the value of \$20,000.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That said corporation may purchase and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding, at any one time, twenty thousand dollars; and may erect

on such real estate, any works, machines and buildings, that may be necessary or useful, in carrying on the business of said corporation.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That the powers granted by this Act, may be enlarged, restricted or annulled at the pleasure of the Legislature.

Powers herein granted subject to revision by Legislature.



CHAP. 99.

AN additional ACT to incorporate the Proprietors of Old Town Bridge.

Approved, March 15, 1830.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the term of two years from and after the passing of this Act, be, and hereby is granted to the Proprietors of Old Town Bridge, in the town of Orono, and county of Penobscot, to build and complete said Bridge, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

Proprietors allowed a further time of two years, to build said bridge.



CHAP. 100.

AN ACT to repeal the laws relating to the Salmon, Shad and Alewife Fishery in the river Kennebec, in the county of Kennebec.

Approved March 15, 1830.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That all laws heretofore made, relating to the Salmon, Shad or Alewife Fisheries, so far as the same are now in force, in the river Kennebec, in the county of Kennebec, be, and the same are hereby repeal-

Laws repealed except, &c.
