CHAP. 50.

Resolve on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Approved March 19, 1830.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State to the several persons mentioned in the preceding Roll, the several sums set against their respective names, amounting to twenty four thousand two hundred and nineteen dollars and fifty cents.
