#### CHAPTER DXVI.

AN ACT respecting the anchoring of vessels on the fishing grounds near the Manannas and Monhegan Islands.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That from and after the first day of August next, it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to anchor any vessel or vessels on the her-vessels not to ring grounds so called included between a line on the herring drawn from the North point of Manannas Island grounds near to the West end of the Eastern Duck Island on and Monhethe one side, and the Islands of Monhegan and Smutty Nose on the other; and if any person or persons shall offend against the provisions of this Act, he shall forfeit and pay a fine of not less than two dollars, nor more than ten dollars for each Penalty and offence, to be recovered in an action of debt, in how recoverany Court of competent jurisdiction, to the use ed. of the person who shall sue therefor; Provided,
That no person shall be liable for the above pen-ther sufficient alty, who in consequence of stress of weather, or excuse, if vessel is removed by any disaster may find it necessary to anchor on as soon as the said ground for safety, and who shall as soon practicable. as practicable move therefrom.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That any Justice of the Peace within the County of Lincoln, is hereby empowered to issue his warrant to Inhabitants of some inhabitant of the Island of Monhegan, di-Monhegan Island may elect recting him to notify the inhabitants thereof to a Harbour Master. meet at such time and place as he shall appoint, for the choice of a Harbour Master, and the persons so assembled, may choose by ballot some Election to be suitable person, an inhabitant of said Island, to fill such office, whose duty it shall be, to see that Harbour Masthe provisions contained in the first section of this ter's duty. act shall be duly observed and enforced.
