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### CHAPTER 133.

AN ACT additional to an Act, to incorporate the Cumberland Insurance Company.

Approved February 16, 1831.

*BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That a further time of five years from the passing of this Act, is hereby granted to the Cumberland Insurance Company to pay in their Capital Stock, at such times, and in such instalments and under such penalties as the Directors for the time being shall direct; any thing contained in the Act to which this is additional, to the contrary notwithstanding.*

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### CHAPTER 134.

AN ACT establishing a Fire Department in the town of Portland.

Approved February 19, 1831.

**SECT. 1.** *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Fire Department of the town of Portland shall hereafter consist of one Chief Engineer and as many other Engineers, Fire Wards, Fire men, Hose men, Hook and Ladder men, Axe and Sail men as the Selectmen of said town from time to time, may nominate and appoint, not exceeding three hundred in addition to the number at present employed.*
