CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT additional to an Act to incorporate the Waterville Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Approved March 25, 1831.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT additional to an Act to incorporate the Proprietors of the Bangor Pier Corporation.

Approved March 25, 1831.
