SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with the pro-Acts repealed. visions of this Act be, and hereby are repealed, so far as such Acts or provisions, relate to any wear or wears, which may be erected in Penobscot river, Northerly of Sandy Point.

CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT additional to the several Acts for the preservation of Fish in Penobscot River and Bay, and the several streams emptying into the same.

Approved March 25, 1831.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled. That the Court of Sessions, in the County of Penobscot, at their session next preceding the first day of May annually, shall appoint some suitable Fish Warden person residing in one of the towns of Atkinson, ed in Atkinson, Sebec, Foxcroft or Dover, to be a Fish Warden, Sebec, Foxwho shall be sworn to the faithful discharge of his trust; be subject to the duties and liabilities, Duties and liabilities. and entitled to the privileges and immunities, as provided in an Act additional to the several Acts for the preservation of Fish, in Penobscot river and bay, and the several streams emptying into the same, passed March the third, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twentynine.
