**Chapter 9.**

Resolve in favor of Ezra Hutchins.

Approved February 5, 1831.

*Resolved*, That there be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Ezra Hutchins of Bangor, twenty-five dollars, as a remuneration for expenses incurred in searching for a plantation described as Number One in the second range East of Penobscot River, which he purchased of the State, but which he has been unable to find ; and also in full for all such sums as he may have paid therefor ; *Provided however*, That said Hutchins shall first relinquish all claim under his said purchase.

**Chapter 10.**

Resolve in favor of Elkanah McLellan.

Approved February 5, 1831.

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury to Elkanah McLellan, sixty six dollars and fifty five cents, in full compensation for moneys expended and paid by him for pursuing and causing to be apprehended, Austin Freeborn and Benning Bracket, Jr. fugitives from justice. And the Governor, with advice of Council, is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for the same.

**Chapter 11.**

Resolve authorizing the town of Whiting to raise money for the purpose of making and repairing highways.

Approved February 5, 1831.

*Resolved*, That the inhabitants of the town of Whiting in the County of Washington, be, and hereby are authorized in legal town meeting to raise money by a tax for the purpose of making, and repairing the public highways in said town.
