Chapter 82.

Resolve for the payment of Accounts against the State.

Approved April 1, 1831.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons mentioned in the additional Roll of Accounts, No. 12 the sums set against such persons' names respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of one thousand one hundred and seventeen dollars and forty seven cents in full discharge of the accounts and demands to which they refer.
