Chapter 85.

Resolve for the purchase of Stationary.

Approved April 1, 1831.

Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of Five Hundred dollars for the purchase of Stationary and other articles, necessary for the use of the several offices and of the Legislature, not otherwise provided for ; to be placed in the hands of the Secretary of State, and for the faithful expenditure of which he is to be accountable.

Chapter 86.

Resolve establishing a Valuation for the State, March twenty-ninth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one.

Approved April 1, 1831.

Resolved, That the number of Polls and amount of Estates, annexed to the several towns and Plantations in the several Counties, and the aggregate of the several Counties in the foregoing schedule be, and the same are, hereby established as the true number of Polls, and valuation of Estates of taxable Polls and Estates of this State, until the further order of the Legislature.

Chapter 87.

Resolve providing for the appointment of a person to take care of the Military property of the State in Portland.

Approved April 1, 1831.

Resolved, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized, with the advice and consent of the Council, whenever he may deem it necessary, to appoint some suitable person to have the care and custody of the Military property of the State remaining in the town of Portland, and to perform all the duties of Quarter Master so far as they are to be performed at that place and may relate to preserving and repairing the
