CHAPTER DXXII.

AN ACT in addition to "an Act regulating bail in Civil Actions."

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That when bail is given at the gaol after commitment, in any civil action for the appearance of the party to answer the suit, and to abide the order and judgment of the Court thereon, it shall be the duty of the gaoler to return the bail bond, so taken by him, to the Court or Justice before whom the original writ was returnable.

Bail bond given at the gaol to be returned by gaoler to Court of Justice.
