Chapter 10.

AN ACT to repeal An Act respecting Alewives in certain streams in the town of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That an Act entitled "an Act to regulate the taking of alewives in Winslow's stream and Leach's stream in the town of Penobscot," passed the sixteenth day Act passed 16th of February one thousand eight hundred and twenty of Feb. 1828eight, be and hereby is repealed.

Chapter 11.

AN ACT relative to the appointment of Clerks of the Judicial Courts.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Act entitled An additional Act respecting the appointment of Clerks of the Judicial

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted. That all Clerks now in Office, appointed by virtue of the office shall hold Acts hereby repealed, shall hold and exercise their their office four aforesaid offices for the term of four years from the time of their ap- time of their respective appointments, and no longer, unless reappointed by the Governor with consent of

Council. But all such Clerks shall be at all times Subject to re-subject to removal by the Governor, with consent moval by the of Council.

Chapter 12.

AN ACT to alter the time of holding a meeting of the County Commissioners in the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That a meeting of the County Commissioners for the Coun-ty of Penobscot shall hereafter be held at Bangor Meeting to be in and for said County on the first Tuesday of Au-Tuesday of Au-gust in each year instead of the first Tuesday of gust, annually. September as now by law established.
