AN ACT additional to the several Acts for the preservation of Fish in Penobscot river and Bay and the several streams emptying into the same.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the County Commissioners of the Counties of Hancock, Penobscot and Waldo shall, at waldo shall in- their respective sessions held next preceding the first day of May annually, instead of appointing one fish persons for fish warden in each of said Counties, as provided for by wardens, in an Act passed the third day of March one thous-Counties; who and eight hundred and twenty nine, appoint two persons for fish wardens in each of said Counties. who shall be sworn to the faithful performance of their trust.
