### Chapter 47.

#### AN ACT altering the time of holding the Court of Common Pleas in the County of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the term of the Court of Common Pleas, which is now Court of Com-holden by law, upon the fourth Tuesday of July mon Pleas to be annually, for and within the County of Waldo, shall County on the from and after the passing of this Act be holden up-<sup>3d</sup> Tuesday of on the third Tuesday of June in each year.
