**Chapter 104.**

Resolve respecting the Journals of the Legislature.

Approved March 9, 1832.

*Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Senate and Clerk of the House of Representatives be and they are hereby required to complete their Journals respectively and deliver the same into the office of Secretary of State, within forty days from the close of each session of the Legislature.
