CHAPTER 287.

AN ACT to incorporate the Town of Wesley.

Approved January 24, 1833.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That the tract of land hereinafter described, with the Inhabitants thereof, in the County of Washington, be, and the same hereby is, incorporated into a Town by the name of Wesley: viz. Beginning in the East line of township No. thirty one, in the Middle Division, at a point two miles North from the North line of township No. twenty five, in the East Division; thence running Eastwardly, parallel to said north line, to the town of Crawford; thence Southwardly, by the West line of Crawford and of township No. nineteen, in the East Division, to the North line of township No. twenty four, in the East Division; thence by said North line Westwardly to the East line of township No. twenty five, in the Middle Division; thence Northwardly by said East line, and continuing the same course of said East line, to the first named boundary.

Boundaries described.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That any Justice of the Peace for said County may issue his warrant, directing some inhabitant to notify the Inhabitants of said town to meet, at a time and place in said warrant specified, to choose all necessary town officers.

Meeting for choice of officers—how called.

SECT. 3. *Be it further enacted,* That for the choice of Representatives to the Legislature of the State, the said town of Wesley shall be added to, and classed with, the District, now composed of East Machias, Whiting and townships No. thirteen, eighteen, twenty four and twenty five.

To be classed with District composed of East Machias, &c.
