CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT to incorporate the Penobscot Stage Company.

Approved February 9, 1833.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That James Thomas and his associates, successors and assigns be, and hereby are, incorporated into a Company by the name of the Penobscot Stage Company, for the purpose of establishing and continuing a line of Stages from Augusta to Bangor, and from Bangor to Houlton and Ellsworth, with power to defend and prosecute suits at law; to have a common seal; make by-laws for the management of the Company, not inconsistent with the laws of the State; take and hold any real and personal estate, to an amount not exceeding Forty Five Thousand Dollars at any one time; and the same convey at pleasure; and generally to have, exercise and enjoy all the privileges, rights and powers, usually granted to similar Corporations; and the said James Thomas may convene the first meeting of said Corporation, first giving to his associates such notice as he may think suitable.

CHAPTER 312.

AN ACT to incorporate the Bangor and Pushaw Pond Canal Company.

Approved February 10, 1833.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Mark Trafton, Amos M. Roberts, Hermon Fisher, J. M. Woodman, Elias T. Aldrich, Joseph Treat, John Bright, Daniel W. Bradley, Peter H. Hesseltime, Isaac Hodsdon, Levi Bradley, John Hodgdon, E. G. Rawson, Seth Emery, John Berry, John E. Hesseltime, John Trafton, David Nye with their associates, and successors, be and they are incorporated into a body politic by the name of the Pushaw Canal Company with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal*
